If it wasn't for you we wouldn't be here.

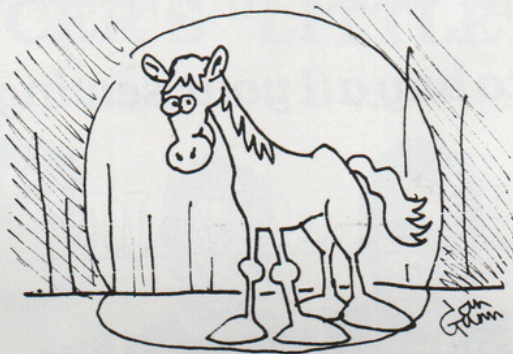
