This is truly a magnificent team effort - one which I am extremely proud to be part of.



So sit back, relax and enjoy their performance of Whitehorse Showtime 1986.







SCOUTING AROUND BOX HILL

The aim of the Scout Movement world-wide is to encourage the physical, mental, social and spiritual development of young people. I believe Whitehorse Showtime does that very thing, perhaps in a different way.

The commitment of those who are involved with the Show is heavy as our policy is that youth who wish to be part of the Show Team must be active members of a regular Scout or Guide Group. Thus the commitment of time to the Show is additional to normal activities, but those who wear the lilac scarf are proud to be part of a team, both on and off stage, who put the Show together.

Whitehorse Showtime is a part of the total Scouting scene in Box Hill, which regularly (i.e. weekly) involves over 600 youth and over 100 adult volunteer leaders.

Perhaps we do not have the public exposure of yester-year, but there continues to be proof that "Scouts" do take a more constructive place in society as responsible citizens.

GUIDING IN BOX HILL

1986, fifty five years since a handful of adventurous girls formed the first Guide Unit here and the Box Hill Division (Box Hill, Bennettswood, Surrey Hills and Wattle Park) now caters week by week to over 300 girls from the ages of 7 to 18 years.

The Brownies, Guides and Rangers meet weekly in Guide Halls throughout the City. Their programme revolves around the Promise and Law and covers the areas of service, outdoor activities, the arts, health and first aid and homecrafts.

All units attend Pack holidays or camp regularly and these events are usually the highlight of the year. The girls join with others each year on a district or divison basis for such activities as Field Days, Church Parades, Brownie Revels or other celebrations.

Leaders and girls are supported by the Local Associations who are parent bodies formed to raise funds, maintain halls and properties and be a support in any other way that is necessary.

Although there are waiting lists for some units, new girls are always welcome as are adult leaders.






